STATEMENT ON CLOSURE OF CAMPUSES

- The University Management Board, on 31st December 2020, and the Senate, during its Special meeting held on Tuesday, 12th January 2021, resolved to effect the final closure the following Campuses: Mumias, Kisumu, Kapsabet and Nairobi.
- The affected students have been advised to immediately report to the Main Campus for placement.
- Closure of these Campuses is part of a restructuring process which has been going on for a while. The aim is to improve on efficiency and effectiveness of our services.
- Students currently placed in these Campuses will take Semester One examinations at their various learning centres.
- They will eventually be relocated and placed in other Campuses of their choice. The other Campuses include the Main Campus, Webuye and Bungoma.
- A Committee of Senate has been put in place to oversee smooth transition of this process.
- We wish to assure the affected students that this transition will not affect the continuity of their studies.
- Emerging issues out of this transition shall be given preference and will be handled on a case to case basis.
