5. Promote local and international sustainable linkages and partnerships with other institutions, by undertaking five (5) Memorandum of Understandings annually

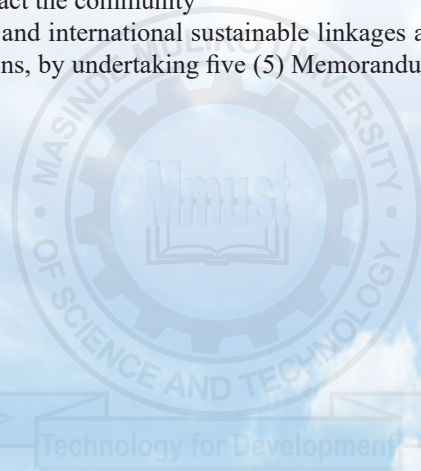
