




MASINDE MULIRO UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY
VICE CHANCELLOR'S ROUND UP FOR THE WEEK ENDING,
FRIDAY, 10TH MARCH, 2022.

- The Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology's (MMUST) wardens underwent an intensive two-day training on basic counseling skills, during the induction of the newly appointed wardens. The training, which took place from 7th March to 8th March 2023, was graced by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Academic and Student Affairs. Thirty-seven (37) wardens were equipped with basic counseling skills in an effort to enhance their central role of safeguarding and maintaining student welfare in their different areas of residence. The training was organized by the Office of the Dean of Students.
- MMUST is set to collaborate with Sports Kenya in the development of the Olympic Standard Swimming Pool to promote Sports Science. This was evident during a visit by a delegation from Sports Kenya to the office of the Dean, School of Public Health Biomedical Sciences and Technology (SPHBS&T) on 8th March, 2023. The delegation, whose mandate is to develop sports facilities in the nation, is committed to developing a swimming pool that meets the minimum requirements of the International Sports Federation.
- MMUST led by the Vice Chancellor joined the rest of the world in commemorating the International Women's Day (IWD) themed '*DigitALL: Innovation and Technology for Gender Equality*'. This event graced by the First Lady, of Kakamega County, Prof. Janet Barasa, was held on 8th March 2023, at the Kakamega Rehabilitation School. This is the day when we recognize the achievements of women globally, and take stock of our progress toward gender equity. It also offers an opportunity to celebrate the positive spirit of feminine power and the dedication to stand on par with men in society.
- The MMUST's AIDS Control, Gender, and Disability Mainstreaming Unit (ACGDMU) has continued to advocate for the inclusion of People with Disabilities (PWDs) in the University as they celebrate Disability Awareness Day which was conducted on 8th March, 2023. The event themed, '*Transforming Solutions for Inclusive Development; the Role of Fueling an Accessible and Equitable World*' was marked by a procession from the University Library to the Graduation Square where the exercise was held. The event was graced by the Registrar (Planning, Research, and Innovation), who was representing the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Planning, Research, and Innovation).

- The 6th MMUSO Student Executive Council (SEC) on 9th March, 2023, met the Vice-Chancellor for the first time since it took over the office. The student leaders had the opportunity to hold an introductory session with the Vice-Chancellor, where they got acquainted with each other and discussed the way forward.
- On 9th March, 2023, MMUST hosted the Shieywe Ward Member of County Assembly (MCA), Hon. Moses Musundi. The aim of the visit was to enhance the relationship between MMUST and the Ward. This comes after the University acquired land in Shieywe Ward, where affordable housing units for MMUST staff and students are set to be built. The MCA paid a courtesy call on the Vice Chancellor accompanied by the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academic and Students Affairs), Ag. Registrar (Planning Research and Innovation), Director (Quality Assurance, and Senior Administrator from the office of the Dean of students.
- Today, 10th March 2023, MMUST hosted the Nation Media Group (NMG) for the County Edition where they conducted a live interview with the Vice Chancellor. This package also encompassed news broadcast from the University, two (2) thirty second advert for one week, one feature story to be published on the NMG news bulletin and a talk from Nation Media to the University students pursuing media courses.
