- A group of education researchers at Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST) are set to support and empower neurodivergent individuals through digital transformation. This comes after their project, titled '*Digital transformation for Neuro-diversity Inclusion in Africa and Asia (AAN-DI)*', won funding from the European Union-under the Erasmus+ programme. The project, whose Principal Investigator (PI) is Dr. Edward Khasakhala Okaya, will ensure the capacity building of staff at four (4) Higher Education Institutions in Kenya as well as in India. The project partners include the University of Jyväskylä-Finland, University of Valencia-Spain, Great Lakes University Kisumu (GLUK), Indian Institute of Technology Bombay (IITB) and University of Kashmir (KU).
- A MMUST Postgraduate student, Mr. Dennis Otworu has been shortlisted among the other successful candidates for the Africa Climate Mobility Academy, following a competitive process conducted by the Climate Mobility Africa Research Network (CMARN) in collaboration with MMUST and CIAT Bioversity Alliance. The candidates will be participating in the mentorship program that will involve a week-long in-person writing workshop that will take place from 13<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> October 2024 that will be hosted at MMUST.
