- Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST) has been earmarked by Changsha Social Work College-China for collaboration in the establishment of international TVET training centres. The two institutions had an online meeting on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 to deliberate on the possibilities of formalizing their partnership through signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). They will collaborate on various aspects including research, staff and students exchange programs, joint talent training and joint construction of training centres.
- MMUST Agricultural research is set to transform the sugarcane farming sector in Kenya. This was evident during the courtesy call by the British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) and West Media Limited teams to the University on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 with the aim of carrying out interviews with specific researchers. - MMUST iHELP project Principal Investigator, Dr. Rose Opiyo, hosted IHELP partners from Kyambogo University on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2022, in preparation for impact assessment of the IHELP project. The team from Kyambogo University were around the entire week visiting the established IHELP centers to assess and evaluate the advancement of the project.
- The British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) journalists visited MMUST with the aim of establishing perceptions of young first- time voters regarding the forthcoming elections. The BBC team was received by the Director, Corporate Communications and Marketing, Dr. Lydia Anyonje and MMUST's Radio Producer, Mr. Elvis Chamegere.
