- Two of the Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST) postgraduate students have received scholarships, courtesy of the African Canadian Continuing Education Society (ACCES), Kenya. This was revealed during a courtesy call made to the Vice Chancellor, by the Executive Director, ACCES, Mr. Kevin Fadum, on Monday, 30th January, 2023. Mr. Fadum was accompanied by the Program Manager ACCES Kenya, Mr. Anthony Kikubu Mutevane, who is also an alumnus of MMUST. The two (2) presented the awards to the Vice Chancellor before the University Management Board (UMB). The two beneficiaries; Mr. Boniface Manoah, who is a staff at the University's security Department and Mr. Kevin Okwara will be pursuing a Master of Criminology and a Master of Economics respectively.
