**VICE CHANCELLOR'S ROUND UP FOR THE WEEK ENDING,**  
**FRIDAY, 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2023**

- Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST), Vice-Chancellor on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2023, visited three University students admitted at the Kakamega County General Teaching and Referral Hospital (KCGH) following an attack by unknown assailants at their residences on Thursday and Saturday night. The VC was accompanied by the Dean of Students, staff from the Directorate of Corporate Communications and Marketing (DCCM), Security, University Clinic and Dean's office, as well as the MMUSO Chairperson.
- MMUST's School of Disaster Management and Humanitarian Assistance (SDMHA), in collaboration with the Disaster Environmental Management Association (DEMA) on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023, carried out community outreach to the Kakamega School for the Deaf. This is a compulsory practical component that is carried out as part of learning every Academic Year. It also fosters humanitarian and disaster components in the students.
- MMUST is hosting officials from the National Council of People with Disability (NCPWD) for a two-day audit on usability and accessibility to reinforce its compliance with the Council's standards. The purpose of this audit is to establish how well the University's buildings perform in relation to access and ease of use by a wide range of potential users, including people with physical mobility and sensory impairments. The exercise which took place on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2023 to Friday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023, is coordinated by the Disability Mainstreaming Committee.
- The National Bank Regional Manager, Mr. Stephen Oyigo, together with his counterpart, the Branch Manager- Kakamega, Ms. Rosemary Kegode, on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2023, paid a courtesy call to the Vice Chancellor. The aim of the visit was to appreciate the University for business opportunities and to explore more possible areas of collaboration between the two institutions.

- MMUST Engineering Students Association (ESA) conducted this year's Engineering Project Exhibitions on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 to recognize the efforts of engineers in the University. The exhibitions brought together MMUST Engineering Alumni, Staff members from the School of Engineering and Built Environment, Institution of Engineers of Kenya (IEK), Engineering- focused organizations and the students pursuing Engineering. This was marked by a tree planting exercise, followed by exhibitions at the Main Catering Unit (MCU) 001.
- MMUST's Bungoma Campus held a Career Day on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 in line with its marketing plan to aid diploma certificate holders as well as form four (4) leavers to access tertiary education at the University. This was also to assist the current students in secondary schools to choose courses offered at the institution.
