### 1) SENIOR LECTURER - GRADE XIII

#### a) Job Purpose

This position is responsible for teaching and supervision of postgraduate and undergraduate students as well as undertaking research that influences theory and practice in a given field.

#### b) Job Description

The Senior Lecturer responsibilities shall include:-

- i) Undertake teaching at undergraduate and graduate levels.
- ii) Undertake research and produce publications or other research outputs.
- iii) Supervise undergraduate and postgraduate research.
- iv) Participate in curriculum development and review.
- v) Examination preparation, administration and management.
- vi) Participate in administration and management of departmental programmes and activities.
- vii) Develop learning materials.
- viii) Undertake community outreach activities.
- ix) Attract research and development funds.
- x) Participate in the development and review of academic programmes.
- xi) Guide and counsel students.
- xii) Where appropriate provide leadership in the department or school.
- xiii) Attending and participating in research conferences and seminars.
- xiv) Perform any other related duty assigned from time to time.

#### c) Job Specification

Minimum requirements:-

- i) An earned PhD in a relevant area from an accredited and recognized University  
**OR**
- ii) An earned Masters from an accredited and recognized University.(For Medicine, Clinical Medicine, Engineering and Software Engineering);
- iii) At least three (3) years teaching experience since last appointment as Lecturer OR Six (6) years in Industry;
- iv) At least thirty two (32) equivalent publication points of which at least sixteen(16) should be from credible refereed journals articles **OR** equivalent scholarly outputs since attainment of Lecturer;
- v) At least three (3) post graduate students supervised to completion since last appointment as Lecturer **OR** For Medicine, Clinical Medicine, Engineering and Software Engineering, at least one (1) Post-graduate student to completion and two (2) in progress at the level of successful defense of proposal at the Graduate School;
- vi) Be registered with relevant professional body where applicable and in good standing;
- vii) Evidence of active Community Outreach /Engagement; and
- viii) Relevant knowledge, skills and competencies.

## 2) TUTORIAL FELLOW - GRADE XI

### a) Job Purpose

This position is responsible for teaching undergraduate students as well as undertaking research that influence theory and practice in a given field. This will be the entry grade for Masters' degree holders into this cadre.

### b) Job Description

- i) Undertake teaching at undergraduate and graduate levels.
- ii) Lead and manage teams in conducting research individually or collaboratively.
- iii) Disseminate research findings through publishing peer reviewed outputs and national and international learned conferences.
- iv) Supervise, advice and mentor postgraduate students and their research.
- v) Write proposals for research and development funding.
- vi) Significantly contribute to the development of academic policies. Lead and coordinate research activities in their subject areas.
- vii) Develop collaborative links and research partnerships with other researchers and institutions within and outside the university.
- viii) Participate in curriculum development and review.
- ix) Guide and mentor early-stage researchers in their training, skills acquisition and career development in their specialization.
- x) Examination preparation, administration and management.
- xi) Participate in administration and management of departmental programmes and activities.
- xii) Undertake community outreach activities.
- xiii) Where appropriate provide leadership in the department or school.
- xiv) Participate in the development and review of academic programmes.
- xv) Attending and participating in research conferences and seminars.
- xvi) Perform any other related duty assigned from time to time.

### c) Job Specification

Minimum requirements:-

- i) Evidence of registration of PhD;
- ii) An earned Master's Degree and a Bachelor's degree from an accredited and recognized University;
- iii) At least eight (8) equivalent publication points from credible refereed journal articles;
- iv) Be registered with relevant professional body where applicable and in good standing;
- v) Evidence of Community Outreach/Engagement; and
- vi) Relevant knowledge, skills and competencies.

### Tenure of Service

The position of Senior Lecturer shall be on Permanent & Pensionable terms upon satisfactory completion of six (6) months probation period. The position of Tutorial Fellow shall be on contract terms.
